STORY:

The name Colorado, meaning “colored red” in Spanish, was given to our state when it became a Territory in 1861 and retained as a mark of pride when Colorado achieved statehood on the Centennial anniversary of the Declaration of Independence in 1876. With great love and admiration for our home state, we dedicate this red blend to Colorado’s vibrant heritage. Crafted from a mix of traditional *Vitis vinifera* grapes and New World cultivars, this wine embodies the spirit of our land—honoring its history while embracing bold innovation. The result is a harmonious expression of old-world elegance and modern vitality, reflecting the rugged beauty and dynamic character that define Colorado’s past and shape its future.

TASTING NOTES:

Introducing our COLORADO Red Blend, an exciting red wine for any adventure under bright blue skies. A subtle note of leather underscores a bouquet of cracked pink peppercorn, violet and blackberry. Its delicate tannins and medium bodied texture deliver notes of dark plum and blackberry. A hint of black tea on the finish leaves you ready for the next sip.

VINTAGE NOTES - 2022:

2022 was a year of new beginnings. Rebounding from a mostly lost vintage the year prior we saw roughly 65% of a normal harvest and a return of some of the *vinifera* grape varieties. The summer also saw a return of average-normal temperatures during the heart of the growing season leading to a long harvest season with even ripening grapes with great balance and symmetry in the resulting wines.
