STORY:

Crafted from our estate-grown fruit, this sparkling wine is a bold fusion of tradition and innovation. Using a unique method that marries the natural, lively essence of pét-nat with the Charmat method, it bursts with vibrant, refreshing bubbles. The result is a wine as untamed as Colorado's high desert—full of energy, spontaneity, and adventure. Each bottle captures the rugged spirit of the West, delivering a naturally effervescent experience that's as bold and unforgettable as the landscape itself.

TASTING NOTES:

The spirited, colorful label is a preview of what's inside the bottle. A vibrant array of strawberry soda, candied orange plus peaches and cream on the nose leads to a burst of fresh apricot and nectarine. The long finish carries a touch orange vanilla crème and an empty glass.

VINTAGE NOTES - 2024:

The 2024 vintage in Colorado's Grand Valley will be remembered for its challenges — and its rewards. A late-spring freeze in May cut yields, but the vines rallied, giving us fruit of remarkable intensity. July's heat pushed ripening forward, while August's cooler days and crisp desert nights slowed things down just enough to let flavors deepen, acids hold, and structure develop with grace. Harvest arrived 10–12 days ahead of average, pushing crews to move quickly before fall frost, yet the fruit remained healthy, with robust skins and lively acids. Though volume was down, the quality was undeniable. The wines of 2024 shine with vibrancy and elegance — vivid aromatics, balanced sugars, and a terroir-driven energy that captures the drama and beauty of farming at the edge of the Rockies.
