TASTING NOTES:

Our Grand Cuvée is 100% Chenin Blanc from the Grand Valley in the traditional bottle fermentation Methode Champenoise style. It's a feast for the senses with an intense bouquet of lemon curd and golden apple alongside mineral notes of river rock and green tea. With each sip, discover a canvas of tropical starfruit and passionfruit with elements of perfectly ripe apricot and tangy kumquat within the fine mousse. Save a space in your wine cellar as this wine will age beautifully but only if you can resist the temptation to enjoy it now.
