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### TASTING NOTES:

Effortlessly elegant, lighthearted yet refined, Rosé La La La dances on the palate with fine bubbles and a fresh burst of wild berries and blooms. It's a sparkling rosé for moments that call for a little extra joy and spontaneity. ### VINTAGE NOTES - 2023:

The 2023 growing season in Horse Heaven Hills started cool and slow, with spring temperatures running below normal. Warmer weather returned in May, setting the stage for a more typical season overall. Yields were lighter, with smaller berries and tighter clusters, which translated into fruit of excellent quality and concentration. Sauvignon Blanc arrived early — as soon as late August — showing vibrant aromatics and lively acidity, while the reds developed great color, structure, and depth. The result is a vintage defined by energy and elegance, with wines that carry both immediate appeal and the promise of age.
