STORY:

In 1859 thousands of gold seekers flocked to Colorado, taking part in one of the greatest gold rushes in North American history. These prospectors were known as “Fifty-Niners.” At Carboy, we consider ourselves prospectors of a different kind, harvesting world-class grapes of exceptional quality from the Grand Valley and using only the finest to produce our signature Vin ‘59 blend - a wine as rich as fortunes made in 1859 and our way of honoring those pioneers.

TASTING NOTES:

For the first time, our flagship wine takes a slight detour from the Right Bank Bordeaux style it has traditionally been. Also, for the first time, a new world cultivar (Chambourcin) makes its first appearance in the blend bringing with it a new wonderful array of alpine characteristics. Claim #22 opens with fresh woody aromas of cedar and wintergreen with undertones of mulling spice and blueberry tea. Dark fruits of brambleberry and black currants carry through on the palate alongside zippy, firm tannins to create the most lively blend of Vin ‘59 to date.
